PARADE LINE UP



THINGS TO NOTE:

Walking-only participants line up on the sidewalk. They will not have chalked numbers on the road. Only vehicles and floats will be on the road. For safety, all walkers should line up on the sidewalk/grass areas.

On Alexander Street, we will have to "double-up" so there will be an inner and outer lane (closest to the sidewalk.) As you show up for staging, please fill in the outer lane first. If your chalk number is in the inner lane, but you arrive before an adjacent outer lane participant, please stage as closely as possible to your number in the outer lane. This will leave space for those arriving to stage in the inner lane without being blocked. When the parade begins to move, please work with your neighboring participants to march in lineup order, as closely as possible.

If you want to take part in the float competition, please make sure your parade number in the plastic sleeve is visible on the driver's side while passing the judges.
