



Seeking **TRANSGENDER TEENS 12-17 YEARS OLD**
for a research study on
GENDER IDENTITY & SUICIDE RISK



❖ **What is this study about?**

- ä This study will improve our understanding of how gender identity and parent-child relationships influence suicidal thoughts and behaviors.

❖ **Who is eligible?**

- ä Teens 12-17 years old living in New York State who identify as transgender, gender-nonconforming, or any other gender minority and who experienced suicidal thoughts or behaviors within the past year.

❖ **What does the study include?**

- ä Teens and a parent/guardian complete a 2-hour assessment over a secure videoconference (i.e., Zoom) to assess history of psychological difficulties and treatment.
- ä Teens complete short daily surveys on their phone for the next 2 weeks. Daily surveys include questions about gender identity, daily events, and self-injurious and suicidal thoughts and behaviors.

❖ **How will you/your child be compensated?**

- ä You are paid in gift cards for each part of the study you complete. Teens have a chance to earn up to \$125 and parent/guardians may earn up to \$75.
